ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION

The Ministry of Agriculture requested the World Bank assistance to explore the potential feasibility of introducing a public-private partnership approach in the management of rural water supply as a way to modernize scheme operations and management and strengthen the governance of the sub-sector. The objective of this assignment is to support the World Bank and the Ministry of Agriculture with the design, development and implementation of a pilot program for Public-Private Partnerships (PPP) in rural water supply. The consultants will assist the team in the following: 1. Scoping and selection of sites to participate in the PPP pilot, which will include a supply chain and stakeholder analysis 2. Conduct the technical, financial, legal, environmental and social due diligence and provide support to transaction design 3. identification of stakeholder support program to assist in successful PPP, including the implementation of a capacity-building program to support potential local companies/entrepreneurs to participate in the tender 4. support the contract management authority in the conduct of the tender and award, including the documentation of lessons learned.
